"Since 1999, the year of our arrival in Vallarom, we have decided to practice organic farming which we believe to be more in line with our objectives and our life choices. From the very beginning we have noticed a gradual and vigorous change in nature that we are aware of. The characteristics of the estate are fundamental for the change: the draining soils, the exposure of the vineyards, the surrounding woods, and the mild and dry climate conditioned by the wind Ora del Garda.
